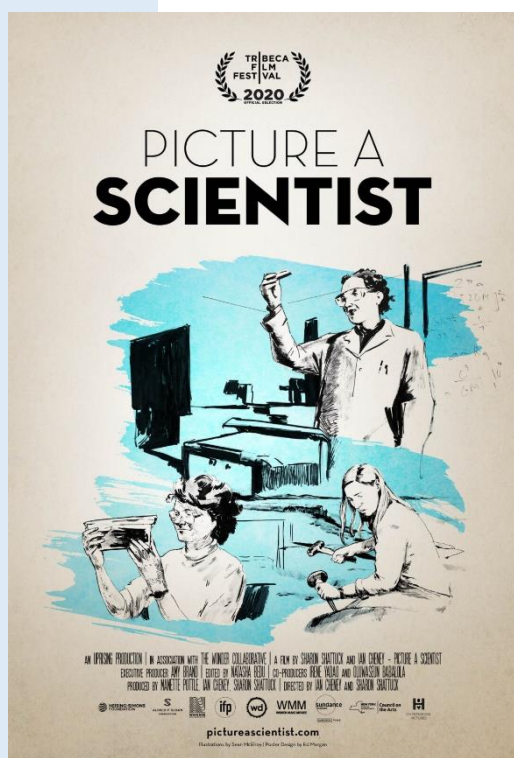


Picture A Scientist Filmscreening + Discussion
